The ability to **identify and trace** the history, **distribution, location** and application of products, parts and materials, to ensure quality and (sustainability) claims.

*Create your own traceability system – start with a **batch/lot number system** – from field to product.*

This information needs to be included:

- ✓ Product code
- ✓ ID of producer /manufacturer / collector/ field
- ✓ ID of processing unit/site
- ✓ Date of collection / harvest / processing
- ✓ and add other for your company relevant information!
